

## Fellowship Program

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The WISER Fellowship program is designed for individuals that would like to participate in a 1 to 2-year curriculum that includes the WISER Foundation, electives, workshops, course observations and a scholarly project. A variety of topics will be addressed by subject matter experts including simulation center operations, information technology, administration and curriculum development.

WISER's Fellowship program began in 2005 and has evolved dramatically since its inception. Over its fifteen years, our Fellowship Program has accepted Simulationists from all over the world with 10 countries and three continents represented. WISER is now one of the first simulation centers to receive accreditation from the Society for Simulation in Healthcare (SSH) for our Fellowship program.

Part of WISER's mission is our commitment to the education and training of healthcare and simulation professionals around the world who have focused a portion of their professional career on becoming proficient in simulation education. We actively seek to contribute to the development, education, and mentorship of future generations of healthcare educators and researchers interested in simulation-based programs

Through the teaching and learning processes that WISER has established, WISER allows our Fellows to advance their use of healthcare simulation and education to improve patient safety, enhance education programs, engage in mentorship, understand systems design, and conduct meaningful research.
